PART 515 OF ACT 451 OF 1994, AS AMENDED, PROVIDES THAT:

- 1. You must have a permit to have an open fire except when the ground is snow covered, or for domestic purposes, or to protect persons or property in case of fire.
- 2. Any person who sets a fire without taking reasonable precautions to prevent the escape thereof or leaves the fire before it is extinguished is guilty of a misdemeanor.
- 3. Any person who maliciously sets a fire which endangers human life or destroys the property of another, may, upon conviction, be assessed a fine of not more than \$10,000, or imprisonment for a term of not over 10 years, or both such fine and imprisonment.
- 4. Any person who negligently allows a fire to escape is liable for all expenses incurred by the State of Michigan in the suppression of such fire.
- 5. Any permit issued may be removed if conditions are such that burning may not be done safely.
- 6. This permit does not supersede any other Act, Ordinance, or Rule which further restricts or prohibits the setting of fires.
