ORDINANCE NO. 830

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 24 OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ALMA TO RESTRICT THE USE OF FIREWORKS TO CERTAIN TIMES ON CERTAIN NATIONAL HOLIDAYS CONSISTENT WITH THE APPLICABLE STATE STATUTE

The City of Alma Ordains:

Section 1. Section 25-2 of Chapter 25 of the Ordinances of the City of Alma is amended to read as follows:

Section 25-2 Prohibition of use of consumer fireworks.

No person shall ignite, discharge or use consumer fireworks within the City of Alma, except, after 11:00 am on December 31st until 1:00 am on January 1st, the Saturday and Sunday immediately preceding Memorial Day until 11:45 pm on each of those days, June 29th through July 4th until 11:45 pm on each of those days, July 5th, if that date is a Friday or Saturday, until 11:45 pm, or the Saturday and Sunday immediately preceding Labor Day until 11:45 pm on each of those days.

Section 2: Separability. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

Section 3: Ordinances Repealed. All ordinances and/or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 4: Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force 15 days from and after its enactment as provided by the City Charter.
